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Pursuant to Title Seven, Section 4237 of the Revised Codes of the State of Montana of 1907, the following persons, C. W. Sinnock, J. O. Higham, C. G. Beckstrom, B. F. Ingram, S. A. Beall, F. A. Simmons, Claud D. Youst, A. J. Ogden and J. L. D. Queen, residents of the town of Belfry, in the County of Carbon and State of Montana, met in the office of C. W. Sinnock in the town of Belfry, Monday, May 10th at 8:30 P. M. for the purpose of forming a Cemetery Association.

C. W. Sinnock was made Chairman, and J. L. D. Queen was made Secretary.

The following business was transacted:

- First. A Cemetery Association was formed which shall be known as, and have the corporate name of The Belfry Cemetery Association.
- Second. This Association shall have power to acquire land for cemetery purposes only, by purchase or otherwise, to improve and embellish the same, to sell lots for burial purposes only, and convey the same by deed or certificate. It shall at all times have full power and control over all such lots sold, as to manner in which lots shall be kept, have power to levy an assessment annually on each lot owner for the purpose of keeping such individual lots in proper shape, to conform to the rules of said Association.
- Third. It is agreed that this Association shall be controlled by a Board of Trustees, One of the first class, one of the second class and one of the third class; and the said trustees were elected as follows:
J. L. D. Queen, First Class, Claud D. Youst, Second Class, C. W. Sinnock, Third Class.
- Fourth. That All Persons hereafter purchasing burial lots, or fractions thereof, from Said Association shall become Associate Members and be eligible to the office of Trustee.
- Fifth. The annual meeting of said members and associate members of this association shall be held the first Monday in May of each succeeding year, at such place and hour as designated by said Board of Trustees.
