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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

3 We, the undersigned, certify that in pursuance to and  
4 in conformity with the Revised Civil Code of the State of  
5 Montana, a meeting was called and held at Howard, Rosebud County,  
6 Montana, on the 14th day of August, A. D. 1915, for the purpose  
7 of organizing a cemetery association, and that the following  
8 persons were present at the said meeting, namely: George Mace,  
9 Sam Newnes, W. H. Armstrong, Arthur Chapin, Lee Robison,  
10 N. Pendelbury, Thos. Tait, Noah Spannagel, and Harry Newnes.

11 And we further certify that the following Articles  
12 of Incorporation was agreed upon and adopted by the majority  
13 of the above parties who were present at the said meeting:

14 FIRST,--That the name of said corporation is,  
15 The Howard Cemetery Association.

16 SECOND,--That the object and aim for which the said  
17 corporation is organized is to provide a place where the  
18 people of the community may bury their dead.

19 THIRD,--That the number of its trustees shall be five,  
20 and these are divided into three classes: The one of the first  
21 class, which is Thos. Tait, shall hold his office for a period  
22 of one year. Those of the second class, which are Noah  
23 Spannagel and Harry Newnes, shall hold their office for a  
24 period of two years. And those of the third class, which  
25 are George Mace and Sam Newnes, shall hold their office for a  
26 period of three years.

27 FOURTH;--That an annual election shall be held on  
28 the last Saturday in August, at Howard, Montana, to elect a  
29 trustee or trustees to fill the vacancy of the class whose term

1 expires on the foregoing day, and these trustees shall be  
2 elected by ballot, and the trustees so elected shall hold  
3 their office for a period of three years.
