A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE POPULATION OF THE CITY OF MILES CITY, MONTANA, AND ADVANCING THE CLASS THEREOF FROM THE THIRD TO THE SECOND CLASS, AS PROVIDED BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF MONTANA IN RELATION THERETO.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILES CITY, CUSTER COUNTY, MONTANA, that,-

WHEREAS, heretofore and on the 27th day of April, A. D. 1915, the City Council at an adjourned and regular meeting thereof, determined that a direct enumeration of the inhabitants of the City of Miles City should be taken, and,-

WHEREAS, the City Council on said date duly and regularly appointed G. S. Otis as the person to take such enumeration, and,-

WHEREAS, the said G. S. Otis duly and regularly qualified for such work by filing his oath of office with the City Clerk of said City, and,-

WHEREAS, the said G. S. Otis has caused to be made direct enumeration of the inhabitants of the City of Miles City, and has made a list of the names of the persons and their places of residence and filed the same with the City Clerk and has duly and regularly attached his Affidavit thereto, which shows that the City of Miles City has now, at the date hereof, a population of Seven Thousand Six Hundred twenty-one (7,621).

NOW THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Miles City, Montana, that a direct enumeration of the inhabitants of the City of Miles City has been duly and regularly made and that from such enumeration the population of said City is hereby fixed and determined to be Seven Thousand, Six Hundred twenty-one (7,621) and;

Be it Further Resolved that the City of Miles City, Montana is hereby declared to be advanced from a city of the third class to a city of the second class and hereafter the classification of said city is hereby declared to be a second class city, under the Laws of the State of Montana in relation thereto until changed in the manner provided by law, and;

Be it Further Resolved that a certified copy of this Resolution be filed in the office of the County Clerk of Custer County, Montana and also in the office of the Secretary of State and that from and after the date of the filing of said Resolution, as aforesaid, that the City of Miles City become a city of the second class.
