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ARTICLE -I-

Section I. The name of this Corporation shall be "The Phoebe Rose Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church ", and the place in which said Corporation shall have its seat shall be the Town of Denton, in Fergus County, Montana.

ARTICLE -II-

Section I. The Purposes for which this Corporation shall exist shall be as follows: The conduct of religious meetings and religious services in the interest of the Christian Religion; the promotion of the cause of Christianity and Christian Morals in the locality in which this Corporation shall have its seat; the employment of agents and ministers for these above purposes; the holding of property , gifts, demises, bequests, and legacies of any nature and kind, in the interest of the above work; the erection of suitable edifices for the housing of the people in pursuance of said work; the ownership and management of the same; and any and all other suitable and necessary things which may be done by a religious corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Montana.

ARTICLE -III-

Section I. The number of Trustees for this Corporation shall be five, and those who shall serve ad such for the first year of this corporate existance are as follows, to-wit;-

George Smith of Denton, Mrs. George Robinson of Denton, Mrs. Robert Holgate of Denton, Fred Cedarholm of Denton, and Reverend Alvin F. Taylor of Denton, all in the County of Fergus, State of Montana.
