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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

- of -

MOUNT SAINT CHARLES COLLEGE.

.....

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That John P. Carroll, Bishop of Helena, in the State of Montana, to-wit, the Roman Catholic Bishop of the diocese of Helena, in the State of Montana; Victor Day, the Vicar General of the said Roman Catholic diocese of Helena; John L. McMullen, the Chancellor of the said Roman Catholic diocese of Helena, have designated and associated with themselves, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the provisions of the Act of the Legislative Assembly of Montana, approved March 14, 1913, as well as under the provisions of Chapter I, of Title VI of the Civil Code of the State of Montana, to-wit, of Sections 4221, 4222 and 4223 of the Revised Codes of the State of Montana, and of all other laws or provisions of law of the State of Montana applicable to religious, college or seminary, corporations, the two persons herein named, to-wit, August D. Leitham, of Bozeman, Montana, and Wm. Scallon, of Helena, Montana, both residents of said diocese and members of the same religious denomination, to-wit, of the Roman Catholic Church, and that these five persons have adopted, and now adopt, the following as the articles of incorporation of such corporation, to-wit:

I.

The said Bishop, Vicar General and Chancellor have duly selected and designated and associated with themselves, for the purpose aforesaid, the said August Leitham and Wm. Scallon.

II.

The name of the corporation shall be

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"MOUNT SAINT CHARLES COLLEGE."

III.

The purpose for which said corporation is organized is the conducting of a college and seminary under the above stated name in the city of Helena, Montana, and, in connection with said college and seminary, to give instruction in all branches of learning, secular as well as religious, and to grant such literary honors as are usually granted by any university, college or seminary of learning in the United States, and in testimony thereof, to give suitable diplomas under the seal of said college and the signature of such officer or officers of the corporation as may be designated for that purpose.

IV.

The place where the college or seminary is to be conducted is, as above stated, Helena, Montana.

V.

The number of members, corporators and trustees of the said corporation shall be five.

The names and residences of the said members, trustees and corporators, are as above stated:

John P. Carroll, Bishop of Helena, Montana, residing at Helena, Montana;

Victor Day, Vicar General of the Diocese of Helena, residing at Helena, Montana;

John L. McMullen, Chancellor of said Diocese, residing at Helena, Montana;

August D. Leitham, residing at Bozeman, Montana; and,

Wm. Scallon, residing at Helena, Montana.

All the members, corporators and trustees of said

to assist in founding the said seminary or college are:

James J. Hill, fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00);
John D. Ryan, ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00);
Mrs. Peter Larson, ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00);
John J. McHatton, five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00);
Mrs. Daniel J. Hennessy, five thousand dollars

(\$5,000.00);

Miss Sarah F. Power, five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).

The Roman Catholic Bishop of Helena contributed the land and the buildings thereon, which land is described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the northwest corner of section thirty (30) in township ten (10) North of Range three (3) West from the Principal Meridian in Montana, and running thence south along the township line 12 chains and 11 links to a point 30 links north of the center of ditch; thence east 17 chains and 65-1/2 links to the east boundary of Lot One (1) in said section thirty (30); thence north 12 chains and 11 links to the northeast corner of said lot No. One (1) of said section thirty (30); thence west along the section line 17 chains and 62 links to the place of beginning, embracing an area of twenty-one and one-half (21-1/2) acres more or less, off the north end of said Lot No. one (1) in said section thirty (30), township ten (10) North of Range three (3) west;

Also a portion of section nineteen (19) in township ten (10) North of Range three (3) West, more particularly described as follows to-wit: Beginning at the southwest corner of section nineteen (19), thence north along the west boundary line of said section nineteen (19) approximately 1148.3 feet to the southerly boundary of the right of way of the Montana Central Railway, through said section nineteen (19); thence southeasterly along the said southerly boundary line of said Montana Central Railway right of way to its intersection with the southerly line of said section nineteen (19); thence west along the south line of said section nineteen (19) to the point of beginning, and containing an area of approximately twenty (20) acres.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF the said persons have signed and executed in duplicate the foregoing Articles of Incorporation, to be filed, as required by the said Act of March 14, 1913, and they also declare it to be their purpose to cause a certified copy of the duplicate filed in the office of the County Clerk and Re-
