The undersigned, as President of a corporation existing under the laws of the State of Montana, does hereby submit the following Restated Articles of Incorporation:

1. The name of the corporation is The Montana Conference Association of Seventh-day Adventists.
2. The corporation is a religious corporation.
3. The name and address of the registered agent of the corporation is as follows:

4. The purposes for which the corporation is formed include:
 - A. A Christian ministry including, but not limited to, the fields of pastoring, evangelism, teaching, literature, health, and stewardship.
 - B. A system of Christian education devoted to the harmonious development of the spiritual, mental, physical, and social powers of mankind.
 - C. Support for the local church, conference, union and worldwide mission programs of the Seventh-day Adventist Church.
 - D. Receive and invest properties received by gift or will and use such property for the charitable purposes of the corporation.
 - E. Serve as personal representative and trustee for church members, in order to facilitate the gifting of property to the corporation.
 - F. Promote and distribute publications consistent with the teachings of the corporation.
 - G. Operate any businesses, including trucking, which may be related to or supporting the purposes of the corporation.
 - H. Perform any other acts which are consistent with and permitted under the laws of the State of Montana.

Each of the above powers shall only be exercised in the furtherance of the exempt
