KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the undersigned, George F. Carson, Chairman, and James H. Morrow, Secretary, first being duly sworn, each for himself, deposes and says:

I.

That a meeting was held on the 20th day of March, 1916, for the purpose of forming a Cemetery Association, and that the following were present: Patrick Nihill, George F. Carson, John B. Weidenborner, Elbert Decker, Harry E. Strong, James H. Morrow, and Oscar M. Ulsaker.

II:

That the corporate name of the said Association, determined upon by a majority of the persons who met, shall be MOORE CEMETERY ASSOCIATION.

III.

That the purpose for which said Association is formed is the procuring and holding of lands to be used exclusively for a cemetery or place of burial of the dead.

IV.

That the number of persons, or trustees fixed upon to manage the concerns of the Association is seven (7).
