



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE WINIFRED CEMETERY ASSOCIATION,  
OF WINIFRED, MONTANA.

This is to certify that on the 25th day of April, 1918, Oscar Anderson, T. W. Reeves, J. H. Wilcox, Axel Refer, E. O. Kindschy, B. A. Cumming and Isaac Palmer all of Winifred and Lewistown, Montana, were present at Lewistown, Montana, as associates for the purpose of forming a cemetery association to procure and hold land to be used exclusively for a cemetery or place for burial for the dead. Such an association was formed, the corporate name of said association decided on by a majority vote of said meeting was the Winifred Cemetery Association.

The number of trustees to manage the affairs of the said association was fixed at four and those elected were Oscar Anderson, T. W. Reeves, J. H. Wilcox and Axel Refer.

The trustees were classified as follows:- The first class trustees to serve for three years were Oscar Anderson, and T. W. Reeves. The second class trustees, to serve for two years was J. H. Wilcox and the third class trustee, to serve for one year was Axel Refer.

The officers of the said Corporation shall be a president, a Vice President, a Secretary and a Treasurer to be elected by the board of directors from their number.

Authority is vested in the president or vice president and Secretary to dispose of lots in any land acquired by the association by giving good and sufficient deeds of conveyance, the consideration for which lots are sold to be stipulated and determined by the board of directors.

The date of the annual election of trustees shall be on the first Monday of May of each year, and all elections shall be by ballot.

We, J. H. Wilcox, Chairman of the said meeting and T. W. Reeves, secretary of the said meeting do hereby certify that the statement
